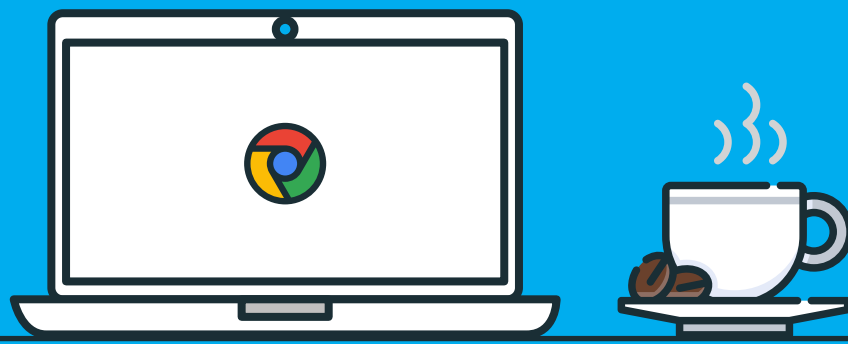


The Espresso Collection

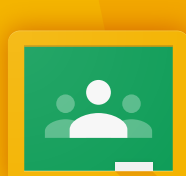

Kickstart

Going Further

Google Classroom – Kickstart Session

Learn the basics to get started with Google Classroom. In this Kickstart Session, we go into setting up your first class, enrolling students and how to efficiently manage and assess progress, while enhancing connections with students, whether in school or at home.



Google Classroom – Going Further

Level up your Classroom abilities in this Going Further Session. We explore deeper uses of Classroom, managing classrooms, automatic file organisation with Google Drive, re-using assignments, marking criteria, assessing student work and self-graded quizzes.

Google Docs – Kickstart Session

Get started with Docs, Sheets and Slides. In this Kickstart Session, we learn the basics of Google Docs and look at how your institution can take advantage of online editing for real-time collaboration. We will introduce some useful tools for input, accessibility, research, collaboration, marking and feedback.

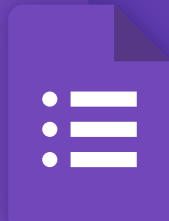


Google Docs – Going Further

Are you already using Docs? Level up your Classroom abilities with this Going Further Session. We explore some hidden features and powerful feedback tools for students. There are also ways to collaborate effectively, including some great Chrome extensions.

Google Forms – Kickstart Session

Learn the basics to get started with Forms. In this Kickstart Session, we explore the ways your school or organisation can get the best out of Google Forms, including how to build a Form and deliver to your audiences with engaging themes, relevant question design and analysing the responses.



Google Forms – Going Further

Level up your Forms abilities in this fun, interactive Going Further Session. We explore building quizzes and interactive stories, setting advanced question options, populating answers to Sheets and powerful add-ons to extend the functionality of Google Forms.

Google Sites – Kickstart Session

Get started with Sites. In this Kickstart Session, we explore the use of Sites to host class content, student e-portfolios, home learning sites and how to create pages and publish to the web with no coding required!



Google Sites – Going Further

Level up your Sites abilities in this Going Further Session. Build internal project hubs, team sites, public-facing websites and more - all without the help of a designer, programmer or IT. We explore ways to make your Site pop with embedded content, navigation and unique layout design.

Google Meet – Kickstart Session

Get started with Google Meet. In this session, we look at how your school or organisation can get the best out of Meet to deliver engaging remote learning sessions. We explore how to share your screen with students and colleagues, options to invite attendees, video and audio controls, chat features and captions.



Google Meet – Going Further

In this session, we show how your school or organisation can level up your Meet skills. We explore advanced Meet options like recording meetings to Drive and Chrome extensions designed to take your virtual classroom to the next level with Google Meet.

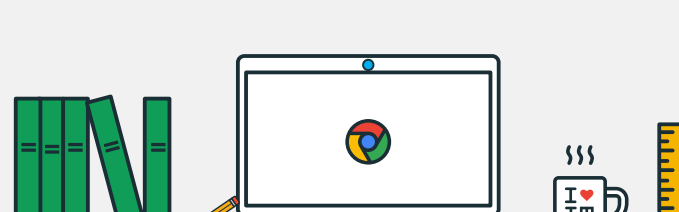
Optimise Your IT Strategy
